Ascension Day on Thursday, 25th **May** is a major feast of the Church year, celebrating Jesus' return to heaven in triumph and the culmination of the Easter season. There will be a Parish Communion service at 8.00 p.m. in St Michael's, probably followed by a visit to The Six Bells...
