Following the theft from St Michael's donations tower last spring and from the collection plate during a service the year before, a **CCTV camera** has now been installed at the back of the nave. This will run constantly but the footage will only ever be accessed in the event of a problem. The parish survey which fed into our Mission Action Plan indicated that having an open church was among the most positivelyreceived things that we do, so it is important to take the necessary minimum measures to keep safe both the building and its users.

We have noticed that wasps and other creatures (mostly smaller and less worrying) are waking from their winter sleep and are both drowsy & grumpy! Please take care if you encounter any of them.
